

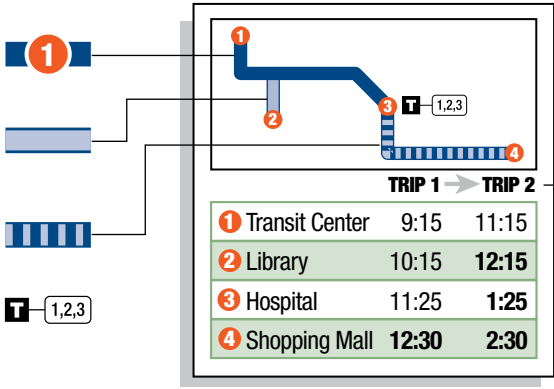
INSTRUCTIONS

The bus stops at this location at listed times. Look for the matching symbol in the timetable.

Only certain trips operate along this portion of the route. See the schedule for trips that provide service here.

The bus operates express along this portion of the route.

Transfer point. Shows where this bus intersects with other routes that are available for transfer.



Bus trips are listed from left to right in the timetable. Light times are A.M.; bold times are P.M.

The bus travels to the locations listed from top to bottom of the timetable. The bus may stop between timepoints.

The timetable shows when the bus is scheduled to depart. Times are approximate and depend upon traffic and weather conditions. Arrive at the bus stop about 10 minutes early to avoid missing the bus.

Riding MMVTA Buses

Locating the Bus: MMVTA bus stops signs and shelters are located throughout Mon Valley communities.

On Valley 1, 2, 4, and Commuter A bus routes, not all stops are listed on the schedule. If no bus stop/shelter is nearby the route you wish to board, wait on the same side of the street the bus travels at a safe location such as a corner at a cross street and "flag" (wave to) the driver as the vehicle approaches.

On MMVTA express bus routes, the bus will stop only at the locations shown on the map or listed in the schedule. Commuter route buses will not "flag" stop for passengers. For more information about catching the bus contact the MMVTA.

Transfers: A transfer is available when a rider is changing routes to complete a trip. When boarding the first bus, riders are asked to tell the driver they are changing routes and then will be instructed to pay the fare amount associated with the full trip to their final destination. Riders will receive a TRANSFER SLIP for their next route. There is NO COST for a transfer.

Holiday, Break & Special Schedules

MMVTA buses will not operate on the following:

- New Year's Day • Easter • Memorial Day • July 4th
- Labor Day • Thanksgiving Day • Christmas Day

Cal Commuter and Valley 2 operate on modified schedules during California University breaks. See individual routes for more info.

Commuter A and the Express routes may operate on SPECIAL schedules specifically around the major holidays of Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's.
